Subject: Official etiquette and protocol

The Chancellery is establishing the protocol about the government of the Consulat of Surland.
The title of Consuls is: His Excellency High Consul, "first", "second" or "third" Consul of Surland.
The title of the High Representative: His Excellency High representative.

For the writing style it can be used "H.E High Consul" or "H.E.H Consul" or simply "First/Second/Third Consul", for the High Representative: "H.E High Representative" or "High Representative".
That's possible for the Consuls or High Representative to be maned by "your Excellency".

To address to the Consul(s) it can be used "Your Excellency" or "First/Second/Third Consul".
To address to the High Representative it can be used "Your Excellency" or "High Representative".

All the documents signed by one of the Consuls will be signed by "the 1st Consul", "the 2nd Consul" or the "3rd Consul".

The Honorific title of "Gentleman or Lady of Surland"

For the writing style the usage wants to use "Gentleman/Lady of Surland".
To address the usage wants to use "Gentleman/Lady" or "Sir/Dame".
