Consular decree n°1

Subject: honorific titles

HONORIFICS TITLES

<u>Reference</u>: to the **article 42** of Surland Constitution, this decree organize the honorific titles.

Article 1

1) The honorifics titles are assigned by Consular decrees. The Concil of Consuls can create honorifics titles by Consular decrees.

Article 2

- 1) The honorifics titles of "Gentleman of Surland" or "lady of Surland" are honorific title assigned by the Concil of Consul, or by a Consul with the agreement of other Consuls.
- 1.1) This honorifics titles of "Gentleman of Surland" or "lady of Surland" can be assigned to any citizen or non citizen of Surland, if they defend the same valor as Surland or for friends of Surland.
- 1.2) the honorifics titles can be revoked in case the person show that he or she has not anymore the dignity to hold it. The decision to revoke the honorific title is taken by the Concil of Consul.
